



MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT

Purpose

1. The NSW Claims Discussion Group is committed to supporting the principles of human rights and opposing all forms of modern slavery. While our activities are small in scale, we recognise the importance of transparency and responsibility in the way we operate.

Our Structure and Activities

2. The NSW Claims Discussion Group is a non-profit organisation that provides professional development training and networking opportunities for the insurance industry. We are volunteer-run. We do not employ staff and we do not operate commercial premises.

Our Supply Chains

3. Our limited supply chains are related to:
 - 3.1 Event venues and catering services
 - 3.2 Printing or promotional materials (used occasionally)

Assessing Risk

4. Given the scale and nature of our activities, we assess our risk of contributing to modern slavery as very low. However, we remain mindful of potential risks in catering, event, and promotional supply chains.

Our Commitments

5. We commit to:
 - 5.1 Where possible, engaging suppliers who share our commitment to ethical and fair labour practices.
 - 5.2 Raising awareness within our volunteer committee about modern slavery risks.
 - 5.3 Reviewing our supply arrangements periodically to identify any concerns.



Responsibility and Review

6. The NSW Claims Discussion Group Committee is responsible for this statement. We will review it every two years to ensure it remains relevant.
